

Congressman Hanna visits Walter Reed Army Medical Center

WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Representative Richard Hanna (R,C,I-NY) this afternoon met with wounded American soldiers, their families and their caregivers on his first visit to Walter Reed Army Medical Center.
