

Why I voted Yes on H.R. 2944, To Provide for the Continued Performance of the Functions of the United States Parole Commission

I voted yes on H.R. 2944, To Provide for the Continued Performance of the Functions of the United States Parole Commission, and for other Purposes. This bill amends the Sentencing Reform Act of 1984 by extending the authority of the United States Parole Commission for an additional three years.
