

I voted Yes on H.R. 298, which designates the U.S. Postal Service facility in Cedar Park, TX, as the Army Specialist Morris Post Office. Specialist Matthew Troy Morris, of Cedar Park, Texas, died on April 6, 2008, as a result of an improvised explosive device in Balad, Iraq. Specialist Morris joined the Army in 2005 and his commendations include the National Defense Service Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, and the Army Service Ribbon.

I support designating this building in Specialist Morris' hometown as one way to remember his sacrifice. The bill passed by a vote of 391 - 0.
