

I voted Yes on H.R. 2422, which designates a U.S. Postal Service facility in Staten Island, NY, as the Sergeant Mendez Post Office. Sergeant Angel Mendez served in the Vietnam War as a United States Marine. He was awarded the Marine Corps' second highest award for personal bravery after giving his life in 1967 during a firefight in which he saved the life of his platoon commander.

I support this Post Office naming in memory of Sergeant Mendez and his sacrifice. The bill was approved by a vote of 390 - 0.
