

I voted Yes on H.R. 2767, to designate the "William T. Trant Post Office Building" in Westfield, Massachusetts.

This legislation would designate a United States Postal Service facility in Massachusetts as the "William T. Trant Post Office Building." Corporal Trant served in World War II and was awarded the Purple Heart for heroism. He was wounded by machine gun fire during the invasion of Normandy. Corporal Trant passed away in 2002. I support this legislation to honor Corporal Trant's service and sacrifice for our nation.
