

I voted Yes on H.R. 4005, the Gauging American Port Security (GAPS) Act.

This bill would direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to conduct a study of gaps in U.S. port security and to submit to Congress a report that includes a prioritization of such gaps and a plan for addressing any gaps discovered. Our homeland security initiatives must begin at our ports and along our borders, and this bill will help to ensure that those ports remain secure and open for the transportation and commercial activities that strengthen our economy by moving and providing the goods and services we depend on.

H.R. 4005 was approved by a vote of 411 – 9.
