

Why I Voted Yes on H.R. 2139, to direct the Treasury to mint and issue \$1 silver coins in commemoration of the Lions Club International.

I voted Yes on H.R. 2139, which would direct the Secretary of the Treasury to mint and issue \$1 silver coins in commemoration of the centennial of the founding of the Lions Club International in 2017. The coins would be sold at a price sufficient to cover all costs incurred by the U.S. government and include a \$10 surcharge to benefit the Lions Club International Foundation.

I support issuing this commemorative coin as a way to honor the Lions Club and its more than 1 million members for their 100 years of service to the global community.

H.R. 2139 was approved by a vote of 376 – 2 – 1.
