

I voted Yes on S. 925, the Mt. Andrea Lawrence Designation Act.

The bill would name a mountain peak on the border of the Ansel Adams Wilderness and Yosemite National Park in California as "Mt. Andrea Lawrence." Andrea Lawrence was an Olympic skier. She won two gold medals at the 1952 Olympics in Oslo, and was founder of the Andrea Lawrence Institute for Mountains and Rivers.

I support this naming of a mountain peak after Andrea Lawrence, who was truly an accomplished American athlete and outdoor enthusiast.

The bill was approved by a vote of 408– 7.
